# Lesson 11: The future

OK, it's time to talk about THE FUTURE.

There are 3 main ways to talk about the future in English.

- 1. will + BASE
- 2. be going to + BASE
- 3. be Ving

## 1. The future with will + Vb

will + BASE is the simplest.

**Use** Will is used especially for <u>prediction</u>. It's often used with "probably" *Example*:

Will it rain tomorrow?

It will not rain tomorrow.

It will probably rain tomorrow.

Form	will is an X-Word.

- "gonna" includes "to" Don't add "to" to the verb. I'm gonna be a millionaire. I'm <del>gonna to be</del> a millionaire.

## 3. be Ving

Use it is used for certain plans or (you're absolutely sure, you have proof) and plans for the near future

#### Example:

I'm going to Florida tomorrow. (I have my ticket. My bags are packed) We're having lunch at Murray's after class.

Form be Ving is the present progressive [am, is, are] + ING) be going (to a place) is very common.

#### Examples:

We're going to Yinjun's concert on Wednesday. Do you want to come?

We're having dinner at 8 o'clock. Don't be late.

I'm leaving tomorrow. My flight is at 9:50.

I'm staying home tonight. I'm too tired to go out.
