Explanation: This is an expanded verb phrase that combines some things that we have learned in earlier lessons. Just remember that the rules never change.

X dtn

after the X-Word "have," always use d-t-n→ has had to

dtn Vb

after "have to" always use $Vb \rightarrow \underline{had to}$ stop

The x-word tells us that we are look at Sohwa's whole life up to now.

The n word, never, comes after the Xword.

The Gerund, smoking, is a noun that answers "What"

Sohwa	has	never	had to stop	smoking

Can you go on the trip? Never an infinitive after an X-Word.

I go to class to speak English. Never an infinitive after a preposition.

3. They want buy a new car.

They want to buy a new car. Never two main verbs together, the 2nd should probably be a gerund or an infinitive..

4. Are you learning speak English?

Are you learning to speak English? Never two main verbs together, the 2nd should probably be a gerund or an infinitive..

5. She should to attend college.

She should attend college. Never an infinitive after an X-Word. Use Vb.

6. Suzy wants to going shopping this afternoon.

Suzy wants to go shopping this afternoon. The form of an infinitive never changes.
